



Considerations When Choosing a Transfer (Bath) Bench



A transfer bench allows a person to sit down on the outside of the tub and then "scoot" over into the tub. The bench legs straddle the tub wall. Some transfer benches have a seat that slides over rails and can rotate. Some have a back and an armrest (on the tub side only). Most models have adjustable legs, useful for users of different heights and for leveling the bench, should the tub floor be higher than the bathroom floor. Padded models and bariatric models are available. Keep in mind that while the padding is more comfortable, it makes moving over the bench surface more difficult.
