



Durable Medical Equipment (DME) Reuse Resources in Massachusetts

Statewide

REquipment Durable Medical Equipment Reuse Program

REquipment provides free, gently used, refurbished, durable medical equipment such as wheelchairs, scooters, sling lifts, shower chairs, tub benches, standers, and adapted strollers. REquipment is the only reuse program in Massachusetts that refurbishes power wheelchairs. Pick-up and delivery are available (for a small fee). With prior approval, donated equipment may also be collected or dropped off at a reuse partner site (a much faster option). REquipment does not provide or accept donations of canes, crutches, commodes, or disposable medical supplies. Visit dmereuse.org to browse the inventory, request equipment, or donate.

Hospital Equipment Loan Program (H.E.L.P)

H.E.L.P. operates on Saturday mornings only (9:00 am - 12:00 pm) by volunteers from the Masons. DME, such as wheelchairs, rollators, tub benches, hospital beds, sling lifts, canes, commodes, etc., is available to borrow free for home use. Pick up only, no delivery.
